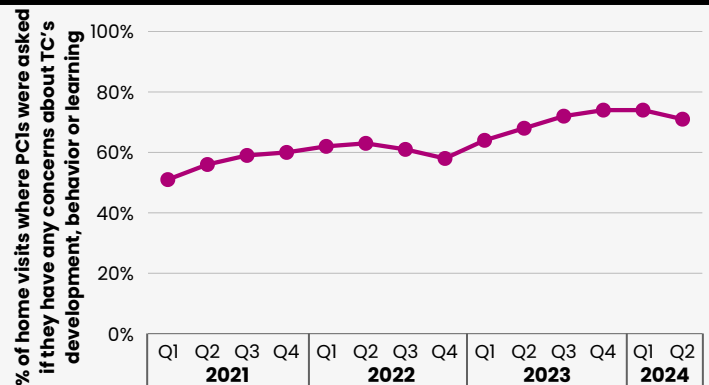
## BEHAVIORAL CONCERNS: FY 2021-2024

### PERFORMANCE MEASURE (PM) 13 DEFINITION

Percent of home visits where PC1s (primary caregivers) were asked by the FSS if they have any concerns regarding TC's (target child's) development, behavior, or learning

### ALL HFNY MIECHV PERFORMANCE

- Recent Performance: **At about 65-75% of home visits**, across all MIECHV programs between Q1 of FY 2023 and Q2 of FY 2024, FSSs asked PC1s whether they have any concerns regarding TC's development, behavior, or learning



### MIS REPORT

The MIS Report, **Summary of Home Visit Log Activities**, can be used to track performance on this item

- Purpose:** Calculates the percentage of completed home visits where the listed activities were performed
- Start and end dates:** Selectable
- Filter:** by Worker or PC1ID
- Cohort:** Cases with at least one Home Visit Log for a completed visit and visits with dates between the selected start and end dates
